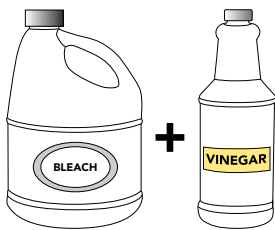




CLEANING PRODUCTS YOU SHOULD NEVER MIX!

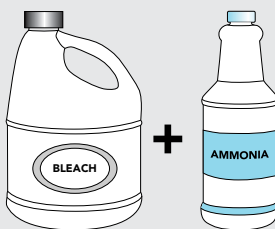
With today's need for constant disinfecting of our homes and offices, we need to remember that certain household cleaning products, when mixed together, can become HIGHLY TOXIC.

DO NOT MIX THESE CLEANING PRODUCTS



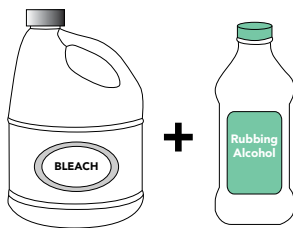
BLEACH + VINEGAR

A bleach and vinegar mixture produces chlorine gas, which can cause coughing, breathing problems, burning and watery eyes.



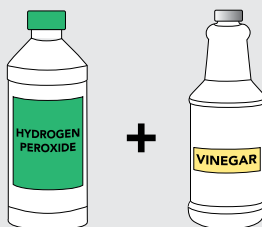
BLEACH + AMMONIA

A bleach and ammonia mixture produces a toxic gas called chloramine. It causes shortness of breath and chest pain.



BLEACH + RUBBING ALCOHOL

A bleach and rubbing alcohol mixture produces chloroform, which is highly toxic.



HYDROGEN PEROXIDE + VINEGAR

A hydrogen peroxide and vinegar mixture produces peracetic/perxyacetic acid, which can be very corrosive.
